Asiania FAI JUDGE TRAINING COURSES:

WUHAN City, China 26th September to 2nd ** October 2013

To be conducted In conjunction with the 15th ASIANIA Parachuting Championship and CHINA International Open 3rd to 13th October 2013

**** Note: FAI Judge Training Course Accuracy practical examinations will be carried out on 3rd and 4th October during official orientation jumps for the 15th Asiania Championships and China Open.**

1.0 INTRODUCTION

- ASIANIA has been conducting approved FAI Judge Training Courses since 2003
- The aim of Asiania is to develop and increase the standard of judging in the Asiania areas.
- To provide the opportunity for national judges and competitors to achieve the FAI Judging standard and proceed to become eligible for nomination as a FAI rated judge.
- Each time a course is planned the nominated FAI IPC Chief of Judge Training personnel are approved and sanctioned by the FAI IPC Chair of Judges Committee to ensure that a high standard of training will be maintained.

2.0 FAI JUDGE TRAINING COURSES will commence at 0900 hours on the 26TH SEPTEMBER 2013.

2.1 ENTRY FEE will be a total of USD 700: (refer to 2.1.1 + 2.1.2)

2.1.1 FAI Judge Training Course USD 300:

Fee will include:

1. Transportation: from Wuhan airport and train stations to hotel and return after the event;
2. Hotel: from arrival on 25th September (night) to October 2nd (night)
3. Meals: from dinner on 25th September to lunch on 2nd October
4. FAI Judge Training Course training, paperwork, examinations, certificates etc.

2.1.2 15th Asiania Parachuting Championships & China Parachuting Open USD 400:

Fee will include:

1. **FAI Judge Training Course Accuracy practical examinations on 3rd and 4th October during the 15th Asiania Parachuting Championships & China Parachuting Open orientation jumping periods.**
2. **Participation at the official Technical Judges Conference on 3rd and 4th October**
3. **Practical Judging experience under supervision, for all events as applicable during the 15th Asiania Parachuting Championships & China Parachuting Open**
4. Transportation: from Wuhan airport and train stations to hotel and return after the event
5. Hotel: From October 3rd (night) to October 12th (night);
6. Meals: From dinner of October 3rd to breakfast of October 13th;
7. Transportation: From hotel to DZ and back during the contest days
8. Welcome and farewell banquets;
9. Souvenirs

3..0 FAI JUDGE TRAINING COURSES OFFERED BY ASIANIA AT THIS EVENT:

Approved FAI IPC Chief of Judge Training (COJT) personnel are selected to carry out the official sanctioned FAI Judge Training Courses conducted by Asiania, as listed below.

3.1 FORMATION SKYDIVING (FS): 4-way and 8-way Formation Skydiving (FS) and 4-way Vertical Formation Skydiving (VFS)

3.2 STYLE: Individual Freefall Style

3.3 ACCURACY LANDING (AL) Precision landing onto a 2cm disc centred on an electronic pad with Automatic Measuring Device)

4.0 REQUIREMENTS FOR FAI JUDGE RATINGS:

As per FAI SPORTING CODE 2013 SECTION 5:

Chapter 6 Judges: 6.3 (6.3.1, 6.3.2, 6.3.3), and 6.4**6.3 Requirements for F.A.I. Parachuting Judge Ratings**

6.3.1 Knowledge of Rules:

An FAI Parachuting Judge must have a detailed knowledge of the Sporting Code, General Section, and Section 5 with its annexes and the Competition Rules for the particular category for which he/she is qualified.

6.3.2 Language:

An FAI Parachuting Judge or a Trainee Judge (6.9.6) must have the ability to communicate so as to allow him to properly understand instructions, participate fully in discussions among Judges or of the Panel of Judges and adequately discuss all aspects of sport parachuting.

6.3.3 Record of Judging Activity:

Each FAI Parachuting Judge must keep a record of their judging activity in a logbook. The IPC Judges' Committee shall keep a record of all judging at First Category Events and the details of any formal evaluation of each Judge.

6.4 INITIAL QUALIFICATION

In addition to the requirements outlined in 6.3, the Judge must satisfy the following conditions in a specific discipline in order to qualify for an F.A.I. Parachuting Judge's Rating in that discipline.

In the three calendar years preceding the IPC meeting at which the list of FAI Parachuting Judges is provided (6.2(2)) the new Judge must:

- a) **Have successfully completed an IPC sanctioned FAI Judge Training Course**

5.0 FAI JUDGE TRAINING COURSE EXAMINATIONS:

1. The courses being conducted at Wuhan, China are IPC sanctioned FAI Judge Training Courses.
2. Candidates will undergo written and practical tests prior to the Official examinations
3. Official FAI Judge Course examinations (written) for FS, Style and Accuracy will be carried at suitable times on the 1st and 2nd September.
4. Official FAI Judge Course examinations (practical) for FS and Style will be carried at suitable times during on the 1st and 2nd September.
5. ** Official FAI Judge Course examinations (practical) for Accuracy will be carried at suitable times during the 3rd and 4th October during the official Orientation Jumping periods.

6.0 FAI Judge Training Course Candidates who hold a NATIONAL rating:

- a) Nominated candidates will be fully trained towards achieving a successful FAI Judge Course standard pass mark.
- b) They must also satisfy the requirements of the FAI SC5 6.3.1 to 6.3.4, to be eligible for nomination by the NAC to the FAI IPC, to be accepted as an FAI judge in the applicable discipline.

7.0 FAI Judge Training Course Candidates who DO NOT hold a NATIONAL rating:

- a) Nominated candidates will be fully trained towards achieving a successful FAI Judge Course standard pass mark and will receive additional training where possible.
- b) They must also satisfy the requirements of the FAI SC5 6.3.1 to 6.3.4, to be eligible for nomination by the NAC to the FAI IPC, to be accepted as an FAI judge in the applicable discipline.

8.0 Asiania NATIONAL Rating:

- a) If a candidate fails to achieve the FAI standard (85%), but achieves the Asiania national standard pass mark which is 10% lower than the pass mark required for an FAI pass in theory and practical work, they may be rated as an Asiania National judge which may be accepted by their NAC for a national rating in that country.

- b) Asiania rated candidates may continue to work towards achieving the FAI standard at a future approved FAI Judge Training Course.

9.0 CONTINUATION FAI JUDGE TRAINING PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE:

- 9.1 FAI Judge Training Course Candidates will carry out practical judge training under supervision for the applicable events during the 15th Asiania Parachuting Championship and China International Open.
